### THEATRE

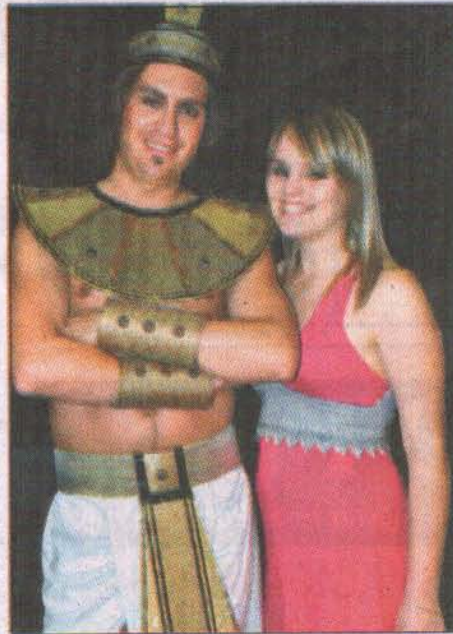
